BILL

further to amend the Goa. Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles (Taxation on Passengers and Goods) Act, 1974.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Goa in the Fifty-third Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be called the Goa Motor Vehicles (Taxation on Passengers and Goods) (Amendment) Act, 2002.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of Schedule.— In the Schedule appended to the Goa, Daman and Diu Motor Vehicles (Taxation on Passengers and Goods) Act, 1974, (Act 7 of 1974), in clause (1), in sub-clause (a)- (i) for item (iii), the following shall be substituted namely:—
 - "(iii) Vehicles in respect of which permits have been issued under section 88(9) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), registered in the State of Goa:—
 - (i) For a big bus, rupees one hundred, per seat, per month or rupees three thousand five hundred per month, whichever is higher.
 - (ii) For a mini bus, rupees one hundred, per seat, per month or rupees two thousand five hundred per month, whichever is higher.

- (iii) For maxi-cabs, rupees Seventy, per seat, per month."
 - (ii) for item (iv), the following shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "(iv) Vehicles in respect of which permits have been issued under section 88 (9) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988), registered in a State other than the State of Goa and plying in the State of Goa;—
- (i) For a big bus, rupees two hundred, per seat, per month or rupees seven thousand per month, whichever is higher;
- (ii) For a mini bus, rupees two hundred, per seat, per month or rupees five thousand, per month, whichever is higher."
